## 15.204-1 Uniform contract format.

- (a) *Contracting officers shall* prepare *solicitations* and resulting contracts using the uniform contract format outlined in Table 15-1 of this subsection.
- (b) Solicitations using the uniform contract format shall include Parts I, II, III, and IV (see  $\underline{15.204-2}$  through  $\underline{15.204-5}$ ). Upon award, contracting officers shall not physically include Part IV in the resulting contract, but shall retain it in the contract file. (See  $\underline{4.1201}$ (c).) The representations and certifications are incorporated by reference in the contract by using  $\underline{52.204-19}$  (see  $\underline{4.1202}$ (b)) or for acquisitions of commercial products and commercial services see  $\underline{52.212-4}$ (v).
