## 15.207 Handling proposals and information.

- (a) Upon receipt at the location specified in the *solicitation*, proposals and information received in response to a request for information (RFI) *shall* be marked with the date and time of receipt and *shall* be transmitted to the designated officials.
- (b) Proposals *shall* be safeguarded from unauthorized disclosure throughout the source selection process. (See <u>3.104</u> regarding the disclosure of *source selection information* (<u>41 U.S.C.chapter 21</u>, Restrictions on Obtaining and Disclosing Certain Information). Information received in response to an RFI *shall* be safeguarded adequately from unauthorized disclosure.
- (c) If any portion of a proposal received by the contracting officer electronically or by facsimile is unreadable, the contracting officer immediately shall notify the offeror and permit the offeror to resubmit the unreadable portion of the proposal. The method and time for resubmission shall be prescribed by the contracting officer after consultation with the offeror, and documented in the file. The resubmission shall be considered as if it were received at the date and time of the original unreadable submission for the purpose of determining timeliness under  $\underline{15.208}$ (a), provided the offeror complies with the time and format requirements for resubmission prescribed by the contracting officer.
