52.105 Procedures for using alternates.

- (a) The FAR accommodates a major variation in a provision or clause by use of an alternate. The FAR prescribes alternates to a given provision or clause in the FAR subject text where the provision or clause is prescribed. The alternates to each provision or clause are titled "Alternate II," "Alternate III," etc.
- (b) When an alternate is used, its date shall be cited along with the date of the basic provision or clause; *e.g.*, <u>52.209-3</u> First Article Approval-Contractor Testing (Oct 1983)-Alternate I (Dec 1983).
- (c) Under certain circumstances, a provision or clause may be used with two or more alternates. In these circumstances, each of the applicable alternates shall be cited, whether incorporated by reference or in full text; *e.g.*, <u>52.209-3</u> First Article Approval-Contractor Testing (Oct 1983)-Alternate I (Dec 1983) and Alternate II (Feb 1984). However, under no circumstances may an alternate to a specific provision or clause be applied to any other provision or clause.
