PGI 233.1—PROTESTS

PGI 233.170 Briefing requirement for protested acquisitions valued at \$1 billion or more.

In the event of a protest of a competitively awarded Major Defense Acquisition Program or of an acquisition of services valued at \$1 billion or more, the agency concerned shall provide a briefing to the Director, Defense Procurement, Acquisition Policy, and Strategic Sourcing, within 10 days of the filing of the protest. The briefing must outline—

- (a) The basis of the protest;
- (b) The agency's position; and
- (c) Any other information the agency deems relevant to the protest.
