#### **GSA ORDER**

Subject: General Services Administration Acquisition Manual; GSAR Case 2024-G503, Updating Leasing Sustainability References

- <u>Purpose</u>. This order transmits a revision to the General Services Administration Acquisition Regulation (GSAR) to update the GSAR to remove reference to the revoked executive order (E.O.) 13514 in Subpart 570.1.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. The General Services Administration (GSA) is amending the General Services Administration Acquisition Regulation (GSAR) to remove a reference to the revoked E.O. 13514 and incorporate the word "sustainability."

Currently the GSAR guidance on sustainable leasing is outdated because it references executive order (E.O.) 13514, Federal Leadership in Environmental, Energy, and Economic Performance, which was revoked on March 19, 2015 with the publication of E.O. 13693, Planning for Federal Sustainability in the Next Decade.

E.O. 13963 was in turn revoked on May 17, 2018 with the publication of E.O. 13834, Efficient Federal Operations. E.O. 13834 was then revoked by E.O. 14057, Executive Order on Catalyzing Clean Energy Industries and Jobs Through Federal Sustainability, issued on December 13, 2021.

Regardless of specific E.O. requirements, leasing has a long history and intent to adopt sustainable practices. To maintain this intent, references to E.O.s will be removed and replaced with the word "sustainability."

Additionally, the website referenced in the GSAR is no longer active and a new web address is being included.
