Subject: General Services Administration Acquisition Manual; GSAM Case 2020-G533,
Correction of FAR Reference

1. Purpose. This order transmits a revision to the General Services Administration Acquisition Manual (GSAM) to correct a FAR reference regarding post-award procedures.
2. Background. GSAR Change 101 revised the text at Part 504 adding the subpart at 504.70 for Supply Chain Risk Management. Further, this change provided guidance for mitigating supply chain risks during the post-award phase of a procurement within 504.7005. In doing so, this subpart referenced FAR Part 43 instead of 49 by mistake. This GSAM case was initiated to correct this error.
3. Effective date. Date of Signature.
4. Explanation of changes. Currently the clause references FAR Part 43 when it should reference FAR Part 49. This fixes a clerical error.

This amendment includes non-regulatory changes. For full text changes of the amendment see Appendix A, GSAM Text Line-In/Line-Out.

This amendment revises the language of the following GSAM subparts, changes summarized below:

A. 504.7005 (b), Post-award procedures

Changing the reference from FAR Part 43 to FAR Part 49.
